## ORDER

WHEREAS Suncor Inc. ("Suncor") applied March 12,

1980 for an Order of the Commission declaring the British

Columbia Petroleum Corporation ("B.C.P.C.") a common

purchaser of natural gas from the Rigel Dunlevy "F" Pool; and

WHEREAS Suncor owns two wells in the Rigel Area,

namely:

Sun E. Rigel 11-17-88-16W6
Sun E. Rigel 6-20-88-16W6

WHEREAS Suncor alleges that it is suffering drainage of raw gas in the Rigel Dunlevy "F" Pool.

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NOW THEREFORE the Commission hereby orders as

follows:

- 1. The Application of Suncor will be heard in public commencing at 9:00 a.m., local time, on Wednesday, July 16, 1980, in the Hearing Room of the Commission on the 21st Floor, 1177 West Hastings Street, Vancouver, British Columbia.
- Persons intending to participate in the hearing should give written Notice on or before Friday, July 4, 1980, to Derek Leach, Secretary, British Columbia Energy Commission; and to Suncor Inc. addressed as follows:
