ORDER

WHEREAS Wainoco Oil and Gas Ltd. ("Wainoco")
applied June 11, 1980 for an Order of the Commission
declaring the British Columbia Petroleum Corporation
("B.C.P.C.") a common purchaser of natural gas from the
Stoddart Belloy A Pool; and

WHEREAS Wainoco owns a well in the Stoddart
Area which tested gas from the Belloy A formation, namely:

Wainoco et al Stoddart 6-4-86-19 W6M

WHEREAS Wainoco alleges that it is suffering
drainage of raw gas in the Stoddart Belloy A Pool.

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NOW THEREFORE the Commission hereby orders as follows:

1. The Application of Wainoco will be heard in public commencing at 9:00 a.m., local time, on Wednesday, August 6, 1980, in the Hearing Room of the Commission on the 21st Floor, 1177 West Hastings Street, Vancouver, British Columbia.
