ORDER

WHEREAS Westgrowth Petroleums Ltd. ("Westgrowth") applied December 3, 1979 for an Order of the Commission declaring the British Columbia Petroleum Corporation ("B.C.P.C.") a common purchaser of natural gas from the Rigel Dunlevy F Pool; and

WHEREAS Westgrowth owns two wells in the Rigel
Area which tested gas from the Dunlevy formation, namely:

Westgrowth et al Rigel 10-25-87-18-W6 Westgrowth et al E Buick b-82-L/94-A-10; and

WHEREAS Westgrowth alleges that it is suffering drainage of raw gas in the Rigel Dunlevy F Pool.

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NOW THEREFORE the Commission hereby orders as

follows:

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- 1. The Application of Westgrowth will be heard in public commencing at 9:00 a.m., local time, on Tuesday, March 25, 1980, in the Hearing Room of the Commission on the 21st Floor, 1177 West Hastings Street, Vancouver, British Columbia.
