ORDER

WHEREAS Orbit Oil & Gas Ltd. ("Orbit") applied

December 3, 1979 for an Order of the Commission declaring the

British Columbia Petroleum Corporation ("B.C.P.C.") a common

purchaser of natural gas from the Rigel Dunlevy F Pool; and

WHEREAS Orbit owns one well in the Rigel Area which tested gas from the Dunlevy formation, namely:

Orbit et al Rigel 10-32-87-17-W6M; and

WHEREAS Orbit alleges that it is suffering drainage of raw gas in the Rigel Dunlevy F Pool.

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NOW THEREFORE the Commission hereby orders as

follows:

- 1. The Application of Orbit will be heard in public commencing at 9:00 a.m., local time, or as soon thereafter as may be possible, on Tuesday, March 25, 1980, in the Hearing Room of the Commission on the 21st Floor, 1177 West Hastings Street, Vancouver, British Columbia.
