O R D E R

WHEREAS Edaltho Enterprises Ltd. ("Edaltho")
applied November 26, 1981 for the payment of a grant in aid
of rural electrification; and

WHEREAS the Commission has reviewed the Appli-
cation and finds that Edaltho is a public utility supplying
electric power to a customer in a remote area, which, due to
insufficient customers would not otherwise receive electric
service at reasonable rates.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission hereby orders that
the amount of \$16,608 be recommended for payment to Edaltho
Enterprises Ltd. pursuant to Section 107 of the Power Act,
the said amount not exceeding 50% of the operating costs for

the supply of power during the 1981/1982 contract year,
(November 1, 1981 to October 31, 1982) in the said rural area
and designates Edaltho Enterprises Ltd., being a public
