CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

WHEREAS Hemlock Valley Electrical Services Ltd.  
("Hemlock") applied August 12, 1982 for a Certificate of  
Public Convenience and Necessity authorizing the construction  
and ownership of a 4.8 mile electric power pole line from  
Morris Valley Road for the purpose of providing an inter-  
connect of Hemlock's electrical distribution system with  
the facilities of British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority  
("B.C. Hydro") permitting supply of basic electric power  
therefrom; and

WHEREAS the Commission has considered the  
material provided by Hemlock in support of its proposal,  
including the fixed-price construction tender submitted by  
Pacific Electrical Installations Ltd. in the amount of  
\$224,691; and

WHEREAS the Commission concludes that the interconnect project is necessary for the public convenience and properly conserves the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission hereby orders  
Hemlock Valley Electrical Services Ltd. as follows:

1. Construction of the project is to commence immediately, with interconnection to B.C. Hydro facilities anticipated not later than December 1, 1982.
2. Appropriate reductions in the Tariff Rate Schedules of Hemlock will be prepared and submitted for Commission approval in a timely manner in contemplation of a December 1, 1982 effective date.
