ORDER

WHEREAS Orbit Oil & Gas Ltd. ("Orbit") applied

January 23, 1981 for an Order of the Commission declaring

the British Columbia Petroleum Corporation ("B.C.P.C.") a

common purchaser of natural gas from the Boundary Lake North

Halfway E Pool; and

WHEREAS Orbit owns a well in the Boundary Lake North Area which tested gas from the Halfway E formation, namely:

Orbit et al N. Boundary 7-22-87-14W6M; and

WHEREAS Orbit alleges that it is suffering drainage of raw gas in the Boundary Lake North Halfway E Pool.

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NOW THEREFORE the Commission hereby orders as

follows:

- 1. The Application of Orbit will be heard on Tuesday, April 28, 1981, commencing at 9:00 a.m., local time, in the Hearing Room of the Commission on the 21st Floor, 1177 West Hastings Street, Vancouver, British Columbia.
- Persons intending to participate in the hearing should give written Notice on or before April 16, 1981, to Derek Leach, Secretary, British Columbia Utilities Commission; and to Orbit Oil & Gas Ltd. addressed as follows:
