ORDER

WHEREAS Silverton Resources Ltd. ("Silverton")
applied March 23, 1981 for an Order of the Commission declaring
the British Columbia Petroleum Corporation ("B.C.P.C.") a
common purchaser of natural gas from the Buick Creek Bluesky
C Pool; and

WHEREAS Silverton owns a well in the Buick Creek
Area which tested gas from the Bluesky C formation, namely:
Silverton et al Rigel b-A22-L/94-A-10; and

WHEREAS Silverton alleges that it is suffering drainage of raw gas in the Buick Creek Bluesky C Pool.

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NOW THEREFORE the Commission hereby orders as

follows:

- 1. The Application of Silverton will be heard on Tuesday, June 2, 1981, commencing at 10:00 a.m., local time, in the Hearing Room of the Commission on the 21st Floor, 1177 West Hastings Street, Vancouver, British Columbia.
