WHEREAS Regal Resources Ltd. ("Regal") applied April 28, 1981 for an Order of the Commission declaring the British Columbia Petroleum Corporation ("B.C.P.C.") a common purchaser of natural gas from the Helmet Slave Point A Pool; and

WHEREAS Regal owns a well in the Helmet Area which tested gas from the Slave Point A formation, namely: Regal et al Helmet d-73-L/94-P-7; and WHEREAS Regal alleges that it is suffering drainage

of raw gas in the Helmet Slave Point A Pool.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission hereby orders as follows:

 The Application of Regal will be heard on Tuesday, July 21, 1981, commencing at 10:00 a.m., local time, in the Hearing Room of the Commission on the 21st Floor, 1177 West Hastings Street, Vancouver, British Columbia.
