WHEREAS the Lieutenant Governor in Council issued Order-in-Council No. 193 February 1, 1982 and directed the Commission to hold hearings on any Applications received for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the construction or operation of a pay-television undertaking; and

WHEREAS the Commission issued a public notice advising of the terms of reference of Order-in-Council No. 193; and

WHEREAS O Sat View applied for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity by an Application dated February 28, 1983; and

WHEREAS the Application was heard by the Commission in Vancouver on April 22, 1983.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders as follows:

1.

Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. T-37-83 issue to O Sat View covering the ownership, construction and operation of a pay-television undertaking serving an area encompassing Oliver and Osoyoos, British Columbia, all as more particularly described in the Application and hearing record, subject to the following condition:

- (a) The service offered by the undertaking must be provided at the rates and under the terms of service described in the Application and the hearing record.
- 2. A complaint which the Commission finds is related to a matter which may be in contravention of the guidelines for enforcement of the obscenity provisions, Criminal Code of Canada may be referred to the Attorney General for investigation and the Commission may suspend the Certificate until such matter is concluded.
- 3. No variation or alteration in the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity or this Order may be made without the approval of the Commission first obtained.
