## ORDER

WHEREAS Inland Natural Gas Co. Ltd. ("Inland") applied October 25, 1985, for Commission approval of a proposed new NGV Conversion Finance Plan to be available to private individuals or corporations for the purpose of converting specified vehicles to dual-fuel natural gas operation in Inland's service area; and

WHEREAS the proposed NGV Conversion Finance Plan is intended to cover the actual cost of vehicle conversions, less any applicable grants, up to a maximum amount of \$2,000 per vehicle, with annual interest rates, predicated on a bank prime rate less than 11%, applicable as follows:

One-year Term - 9%

Two-year Term - 11%

Three-year Term - 14%; and

WHEREAS the Commission has reviewed the Application and supporting material and is satisfied that the proposed NGV Conversion Finance Plan is necessary and in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission hereby orders Inland Natural Gas Co. Ltd. as follows:

- 1. The Commission will accept for filing, effective the date of this Order, appropriate amendments to Section 23.1.1 of its filed Gas Tariff.
- Inland is to advise the Commission at the beginning of each fiscal year on the financial details including bad debts experience, if any, related to this plan.
