WHEREAS the Lieutenant Governor in Council issued Orders-in-Council No. 193 and 194 dated February 1, 1982, and directed the Commission to hold hearings on any Applications received for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the construction and operation of a system of cable undertaking; and

WHEREAS the Commission issued a public notice advising of the terms of reference of Order-in-Council No. 194; and

WHEREAS Copper Valley Cable Ltd. applied for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity by an Application dated July 29, 1986 for Commission approval of an extension of their existing operations, as authorized by Commission Order No. T-72-84, to enable the provision of a Cable Service Undertaking to serve Clinton, British Columbia; and

WHEREAS the Commission has considered the Application and is satisfied with the intent thereof.
