ORDER

WHEREAS amendments to the Utilities Commission Act ("the Act"), including Section 85.3, requires that Energy Supply Contracts ("Contracts") between producers and consumers, be filed with the Commission for approval; and

WHEREAS on August 18, 1988 the Commission issued Rules for the filing of such Contracts; and

WHEREAS Canadian Forest Products Ltd. ("Canfor") has filed with the Commission a natural gas supply contract between the Company and its suppliers - Czar Resources Ltd. and Wainoco Oil Corporation ("Czar/Wainoco"), for the period commencing November 1, 1988 to October 31, 1990 inclusive under Rules - Section 1.2.3; and

WHEREAS the Commission has reviewed the Contract and supporting material and is satisfied that it is in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to Section 85.3 of the Act the Commission approves and accepts for filing the Energy Supply Contract between Canfor and Czar/Wainoco dated November 1, 1988 which is designated as Energy Supply Contract, NGSC No. 2.
