WHEREAS Inland Natural Gas Co. Ltd. ("Inland") applied June 9, 1986 for filing with the Commission an addendum to the Service Agreement between Inland and Consumers Glass Company Limited ("Consumers"); and

WHEREAS the addendum formalizes an undertaking between the two parties in respect of limited relief from the minimum bill provisions during periods when Consumers is required to rebuild its glass furnaces located in its glass plant located in the District of Coldstream, B.C. (near Vernon, B.C.), and is thereby obliged to observe a periodic shut-down; and

WHEREAS the Commission has received the Application and is satisfied with the intent thereof.
