WHEREAS Inland Natural Gas Co. Ltd. ("Inland")
applied November 5, 1987 for Commission approval of rates
applicable to Northwood Pulp and Timber Limited ("Northwood") on
an interim basis, for a one-year term commencing November 1, 1987;
and

WHEREAS Northwood had applied for a hearing of their Application for an Energy Project Certificate which would enable them to construct and operate a bypass pipeline in the Prince George area; and

WHEREAS a public hearing of the bypass application by Northwood has been held; and

WHEREAS the disposition of the Application and Commission Report pursuant to Part 2 of the Utilities Commission Act has not been finally determined; and

WHEREAS Inland and Northwood have now agreed upon interim rates to be applicable to Northwood for a one-year term; and

1. The Commission approves the interim rates as submitted by Inland and will accept for filing a submission by Inland of a Tariff Supplement outlining the rate applicable to Northwood for a one-year term commencing November 1, 1987.
