CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC
CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

WHEREAS Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity C-1-89 dated June 27, 1989 allowed Pacific Northern Gas Ltd. ("PNG") to extend and construct its gas mains to the Village of Port Edward ("the Village"); and

WHEREAS PNG filed cost information pertaining to the extension on September 20, 1989 pursuant to Order No. C-1-89; and

WHEREAS PNG applied August 24, 1989 for approval of a Franchise Agreement ("the Agreement") dated April 24, 1989 between PNG and the Village; and

WHEREAS the Commission has reviewed the Application and supporting documentation and finds that approval of the Agreement is necessary for the public convenience and properly conserves the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to Section 51(4) of the Utilities Commission Act, the Commission approves the Agreement between PNG and the Village which shall expire 21 years from the effective date of the Order, provided that such determination, approval and grant shall not restrict any regulatory power of the Commission.
