ORDER

WHEREAS the Commission has considered the filing deadlines for Columbia Natural Gas Limited ("Columbia") Rate Design Hearing as contained in Commission Order No. G-86-87 and wishes to ensure that all parties likely to be affected are given the opportunity to make submissions and be allowed to file supplemental information.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission hereby orders as follows:

- I. The deadline for Columbia filing supplemental material upon which it proposes to rely is extended to February 1, 1988.
- 2. The deadline for interested parties intending to file a written submission is extended to February 3, 1988.
- 3. Information requests addressed by one party to another shall be delivered to the recipient and other parties and filed with the Commission on or before February 5, 1988.
- 4. Responses to information requests must be delivered to the questioner and other parties and filed with the Commission on or before February 15, 1988.
- 5. Where a party objects to answering an information request, it shall advise the questioner and the Commission of its objection on or before February 10, 1988. Where objection is taken the questioner may make written submission to the Commission on or before February 12, 1988 for an Order compelling a response. The recipient of the question may make a written submission in support of its refusal on or before February 18, 1988 and the Commission will then determine the matter.
- 6. Columbia will lead evidence relevant to the proceeding. The order of other parties will be determined at the commencement of the Hearing.
