O R D E R

WHEREAS on November 24 and December 8, 1988 the Commission received copies of correspondence from National Fuelcorp Limited ("Fuelcorp") a business involved in the conversion of vehicles for natural gas for transportation purposes ("NGV"); and

WHEREAS Fuelcorp alleges that the NGV control of pricing and other aspects of the conversion business is unfairly controlled by B.C. Gas Inc.; and


WHEREAS the Commission has reviewed the complaints from Fuelcorp and believes that the matter requires further investigation.
