ORDER

WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Nelson ("the City") applied May 16, 1989 for Commission approval of the schedule of rates contained in The Nelson Electrical Utility Regulatory Amendment By-Law No. 2321, 1988 ("the By-Law") on a firm basis; and

WHEREAS Commission Order No. G-109-88 approved the rates contained in the By-Law on an interim basis, effective January 1, 1989; and

WHEREAS Commission Decision and Order No. G-24-89 confirmed as firm, interim rates for West Kootenay Power Ltd., the City's power supplier, effective January 1, 1989; and

WHEREAS the Commission has reviewed the Application and finds the confirmation of the interim rates contained in the By-Law is necessary and in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission hereby orders The Corporation of the City of Nelson as follows:

1. The rates contained in Schedule "A" of the Nelson Electrical Utility Regulatory Amendment By-Law No. 2321, 1988 are confirmed as firm effective January 1, 1989.
