ORDER

WHEREAS British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority ("B.C. Hydro") applied February 5, 1988 to amend its Electric and Gas Tariffs, Terms and Conditions, relating to Customer Service and Collection Systems; and

WHEREAS B.C. Hydro's Application reflects changes to its Terms and Conditions by: adding two new items pertaining to "Application for Service", renaming the section "Termination of Supply on Breach of Agreement" to "Refusal to Provide Service and Discontinuance of Service" and introducing a new section, "Rental Premises"; and

WHEREAS the Commission has reviewed the Application and finds that the filing of amendments to the filed Electric and Gas Tariffs, Terms and Conditions, is necessary in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission hereby orders British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority as follows:

- I. Amended Electric and Gas Tariffs, Terms and Conditions, in accordance with the Application are approved for implementation effective February 11, 1988 and are accepted for filing by the Commission as follows:


