O R D E R

WHEREAS Commission Order No. G-90-88 set down for public hearing, to commence Tuesday, November 29, 1988, the Application by the Regional District of Mount Waddington ("the Regional District") requiring British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority ("B.C. Hydro") to extend service to Winter Harbour, B.C.; and

WHEREAS the Hearing was adjourned on November 30, 1988 and set to resume on December 19, 1988 in Vancouver; and

WHEREAS the Regional District applied on December 16, 1988 for a further adjournment in order to obtain additional information and to resolve certain details pertaining to the proposed extension; and

WHEREAS the Commission has considered the request and finds that a further adjournment is in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission hereby Orders as follows:

1. The Public Hearing of the Regional District's Application will resume at 9:00 a.m., Tuesday, January 17, 1989 in the Hearing Room at the Office of the Commission, Fourth Floor, 800 Smithe Street, Vancouver, B.C.


