O R D E R

WHEREAS British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority ("B.C. Hydro") applied September 16, 1988 for Commission approval to continue to include in its operating expenses, subsidy payments for customers of Yoho Power Ltd. ("Yoho") by extending the time period approved by Commission Order No. G-60-88 from September 30, 1988 to June 30, 1989.


WHEREAS the Commission has reviewed the Application and has determined that the payment of the subsidy requested is in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission hereby orders as follows:

1. The Commission approves the subsidy payment by B.C. Hydro to Yoho Power Ltd. applicable to Residential and Commercial Service customers, other than accounts billed to and paid by the Federal Government of Canada, for the period October 1, 1988 to June 30, 1989.
2. The amount of the subsidy is calculated as the difference between the existing rate to residential customers of 21.55 cents/kWh and 7.5 cents/kWh, to be applied to the Residential and qualifying Commercial Service Electric Tariff Rate Schedules of Yoho on the first 550 kWh of actual consumption per month.
3. Yoho will calculate the subsidy for qualifying accounts and submit a monthly bill and a detailed customer statement to B.C. Hydro.
