O R D E R

WHEREAS Commission Order No. G-44-89 ("the Order") required B.C. Hydro and Power Authority to file for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") on electrical transmission projects of 138 kV and above pursuant to Section 51(3) of the Utilities Commission Act; and


WHEREAS the Commission has reviewed the Order and finds that the filing for a CPCN on such projects is required by all Commission regulated utilities.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders Princeton Light and Power Company, Limited ("PLP") as follows:

1. Pursuant to Section 51(3) of the Utilities Commission Act, PLP is ordered to make application to the Commission for a CPCN on all future transmission lines rated at 138 kV and above.
