## ORDER

WHEREAS Pacific Northern Gas Ltd. ("PNG") filed on November 7, 1989, an Application to extend the Incentive Rate with Ocelot Chemicals Inc. ("Ocelot") in the form of Letter Agreements dated October 31, 1989 between PNG and Ocelot and PNG and the British Columbia Petroleum Corporation ("BCPC"); and

WHEREAS the Letter Agreements extend the current Incentive Rate of gas at  $$6.755/10^3 \text{m}^3$$  to Ocelot for the six-month period from November 1, 1989 to April 30, 1990; and

WHEREAS Commission Order No. G-99-88 dated November 10, 1988, approved the Firm Transportation Agreement and Incentive Rate to Ocelot for a two-year period commencing November 1, 1988; and

WHEREAS the Commission has reviewed the Application for extension and is satisfied that the filing properly conserves the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission approves and accepts for filing the following documents effective November 1, 1989:

- 1. Letter Agreement dated October 31, 1989 between PNG and Ocelot approving the Incentive Rate for gas from November 1, 1989 to April 30, 1990 at \$6.755/10<sup>3</sup> m<sup>3</sup>.
- 2. Letter Agreement dated October 31, 1989 between PNG and BCPC approving the extension of the Incentive Rate of 17.5 cents/gigajoule to April 30, 1990.
