O R D E R

WHEREAS Order-in-Council No. 468 dated March 18, 1988, approved the assignment and transfer of the powers and duties of the Minister of Transportation and Highways under Part 7 of the Pipeline Act ("the Act") to the Minister of Energy, Mines and Petroleum Resources; and

WHEREAS Suncor Inc. ("Suncor") applied by letter dated July 6, 1988 for approval and acceptance for filing by the British Columbia Utilities Commission ("the Commission") of the Crude Petroleum Tariff dated August 1, 1984 including Rules and Regulations under Part 7 of the Act; and

WHEREAS the Rates and Rules and Regulations contained in the Tariff apply to the gathering and transportation of crude petroleum by pipeline from the established receiving points of Suncor at Blueberry, Atikin Creek, Inga, West Stoddart, Eagle and Fort St. John areas to Taylor, B.C.; and

WHEREAS The Commission has considered Suncor's Application and finds that it is in accordance with the requirements of the Act.


