O R D E R

WHEREAS amendments to the Utilities Commission Act ("the Act"), including Section 85.3, require that Energy Supply Contracts ("Contracts") between producers and consumers, be filed with the Commission for approval; and

WHEREAS Queen Charlotte Power Corporation ("QCPC") filed with the Commission by letter dated July 27, 1990 a fully executed Contract with Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada ("Government of Canada") covering the supply of power to a radar site near the vicinity of Skidigate Lake for a twenty-year period commencing July 1, 1990; and


WHEREAS the Commission has reviewed the Contract and is satisfied that approval is necessary and in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to Section 85.3 of the Act the Commission hereby orders as follows:

The Commission approves and accepts for filing the Power Connection and Supply Agreement dated June 22, 1990 between QCPC and the Government of Canada which is designated as Energy Supply Contract, ESC No. 5.
