WHEREAS BC Gas Inc., Lower Mainland Division ("BC Gas")  
applied May 7, 1990 for approval of Gas Tariff Supplement No. 15 - Gas  
Service Agreement and negotiated rate dated April 1, 1990 for Imperial Paving  
Limited's asphalt plant at Aldergrove, B.C.; and

WHEREAS BC Gas, under Rate Schedule 2602 - Seasonal  
Off-Peak Service, has negotiated a rate to the customer which will compete  
with waste lubricating oil alternative, effective with consumption on and after  
April 1, 1990; and


WHEREAS the Commission has reviewed the Application and  
supporting material and is satisfied that the negotiated rate will provide a net  
margin to BC Gas and such approval is necessary and in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders BC Gas as follows:

1. Gas Tariff Supplement No. 15 - Gas Service Agreement  
dated April 1, 1990, Seasonal Off-Peak Service to  
Imperial Paving Limited is approved and accepted for  
filing effective April 1, 1990.
