ORDER

WHEREAS Hemlock Valley Electrical Services Ltd. ("HVES") applied May 31, 1990, pursuant to Section 67(2) of the Utilities Commission Act ("the Act"), for a Commission Order granting a rate increase of 7.32¢ per kW.h to all customers; and

WHEREAS Commission Order No. G-51-90 approved an interim increase of $3.70 \notin$ per kW.h, effective July 1, 1990 and required HVES to notify all customers by way of a customer notice; and

WHEREAS the Commission, following receipt of written customer complaints, has now determined that a public hearing of the Application is necessary and in the public interest.

follows:

NOW THEREFORE the Commission hereby orders HVES as

- 1. A public hearing is to commence at 9:00 a.m. local time, Monday, September 24, 1990 at the office of the British Columbia Utilities Commission, Sixth Floor, 900 Howe Street, Vancouver, B.C.
- 2. HVES, by way of direct mailing, will send all customers a copy of the attached Notice of Public Hearing no later than August 10, 1990, and will post the Notice on local community service bulletin boards in order to provide adequate notice to the population in the service area.
- 3. The Application and supporting material are to be made available for inspection at the Head Office of HVES, at the Hemlock Valley Resort Office, Hemlock Valley, B.C.

- 4. HVES is to file with the Commission not later than August 24, 1990 any additional prepared testimony and supplemental material upon which it intends to rely.
- 5. Intervenors and Interested Persons intending to be present and participate in the public hearing should give written Notice of Intention to do so to the Commission Secretary and to the Applicant, to be received not later than September 3, 1990. Such Notice should state the nature of the interest in the proceeding.
- 6. Intervenors and Interested Persons intending to file a written submission should provide one copy to the Commission Secretary, and one copy to the Applicant, to be received not later than September 10, 1990.

THE APPLICATION

Hemlock Valley Electrical Services Ltd. ("HVES") applied May 31, 1990 for a general increase in electrical rates of $7.32 \notin$ per kW.h. The Commission, by Order No. G-51-90, authorized an interim increase of $3.70 \notin$ per kW.h over existing rates, subject to refund with appropriate interest.
