ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On October 31, 1990 BC Gas Inc. Inland Division ("BC Gas") applied to the Commission for approval of an amendment to Gas Tariff Supplement No. 43, and the filing of a Letter Agreement for Husky Oil Operations Limited ("Husky") for service to its oil refinery at Prince George, B.C.; and
- B. The amendments to Tariff Supplement No. 22 require Husky to waive its opt-out rights contained in Clause 12-04 and provide for a reduction in the monthly billing of the Demand Charge component to \$3.298 per month, effective November 1, 1990; and
- C. On January 21, 1991 BC Gas advised that the Letter Agreement dated October 25, 1990 was executed by Husky and that Commission approval was necessary; and
- D. The Commission has reviewed the Application and finds that approval of the amendment is necessary and in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission hereby orders as follows:

1. The Commission accepts for filing for BC Gas, amendments to Gas Tariff Supplement No. 43, Rate Schedule 21, Letter Agreement dated October 25, 1990 for Husky as follows:
