## ORDER

## WHEREAS:

- A. On June 10, 1991 Skeena Cellulose Inc. ("Skeena") applied to the British Columbia Utilities Commission ("the Commission") for exemption from the provisions of the Utilities Commission Act ("the Act"), other than Part 2, in respect of the sale of electricity by Skeena to Canadian Liquid Air ("CLA") oxygen plant on Watson Island; and
- B. British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority has no objection to the sale of power from Skeena to CLA; and
- C. The Commission has considered the Application and is satisfied that an Order exempting Skeena from certain sections of the Act properly conserves the public convenience and interest; and
- D. On September 5, 1991 the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council was given to the said exemption by Order in Council No. 1205, 1991 and is attached as Appendix A; and
- E. The Commission may, pursuant to Section 114 of the Act, reconsider, vary or rescind an Order made by it.

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to its powers under Section 103(3) of the Act the Commission orders as follows:

The sale of power between Skeena and the CLA oxygen plant on Watson Island are exempt from the Act, other than Part 2.
