ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. Commission Order No. G-63-90 approved for British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority ("B.C. Hydro") a Monthly Prepayment on Account Plan and Advance Payment Discount Plan ("Advance Billing"), effective August 16, 1990; and
- B. On September 30, 1991 B.C. Hydro applied to the Commission for approval of a variance to the Electric Tariff for a period of 120 days, to allow for a change in the time required for payment of account by General Service customers under Advance Billing from 10 days to 21 days; and
- C. The Commission has reviewed the Application and finds that approval of a variance to the Electric Tariff is necessary and in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders as follows:

- 1. The Commission approves a variance to B.C. Hydro's Electric Tariff, Terms and Conditions for a period of 120 days, to allow the utility to amend the time required for payment by General Service customers under Advance Billing from 10 days to 21 days, effective immediately.
- 2. Following its review of the Plan and other security and payment options, B.C. Hydro is to file an Application to amend Advance Billing no later than February 28, 1992.
