## WHEREAS:

- A. On May 27, 1992 BC Gas Inc. Lower Mainland Division ("BC Gas") applied to the Commission for approval of Schedule 2501 Sales Agreements for gas sales to Columbia Bitulithic Ltd. ("Columbia") at three locations: Richmond, Coquitlam and Matsqui.
- B. The Agreements replace Tariff Supplements previously approved by Order in Council No. 1550/89; and
- C. The Commission has considered the Application and finds the Agreements necessary and in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission hereby:

Approves the following Tariff Supplements which allow for a sales rate of \$2.10/GJ for interruptible gas sales to Columbia based on minimum annual takes at the three facilities effective for the period January 1, 1992 to December 31, 1992:

Tariff Supplement No. 16	-	Richmond, B.C.
Tariff Supplement No. 17	-	Coquitlam, B.C.
Tariff Supplement No. 18	-	Matsqui, B.C.
