ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On May 27, 1992 BC Gas Inc. Lower Mainland Division ("BC Gas") applied to the Commission for approval of a new Schedule 2501 agreement between BC Gas and Tilbury Cement Limited for the back-up supply of gas to Tilbury's Delta facility; and
- B. The rates reflected in this new agreement are based on the ability of BC Gas to compete with alternate fuels and to recognize Tilbury's desire to use coal as its primary fuel; and
- C. The agreement replaces Tariff Supplement No. 8 approved by Order in Council No. 824; and
- D. The Commission has considered the Application and is satisfied that approval of agreement is necessary and in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission:

Approves and accepts for filing, at the rate of \$3.75/GJ for the period November 1 to March 1 and at the rate of \$1.75/GJ for the period March 1, to November 1, Gas Tariff Supplement No. 8, effective December 9, 1991 as follows:
