**WHEREAS:**


- A. On January 29, 1992, Suncor Inc.-Resources Group ("Suncor") filed with the Commission for approval, Crude Petroleum Tariff No. 121 with rates to be effective March 1, 1992; and
- B. The rates contained in the Tariff apply to the gathering and transportation of crude petroleum from the receiving points of Blueberry, Aitken Creek, Inga, West Stoddart, Eagle and Fort St. John fields to Taylor, B.C.; and
- C. The Commission has considered Suncor's Application and finds that it is in accordance with the requirements of Part 7 of the Pipeline Act; and

**NOW THEREFORE** the Commission hereby approves and accepts for filing the Suncor tariff, effective March 1, 1992 as follows:
