ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On May 5, 1992 BC Gas Inc. Lower Mainland Division ("BC Gas") filed for Commission approval, amendments to Gas Tariff Supplement No. 30, Interruptible Gas Service Agreement covering off-system gas sales with the Vancouver Island Gas Joint Venture ("the Joint Venture"); and
- B. The Agreement will allow BC Gas to supply off-system, interruptible gas to the Joint Venture, for supply at the interconnection between the facilities of BC Gas and Westcoast Energy Inc. at Huntingdon, B.C.; and
- C. BC Gas will charge the Joint Venture at mid-month prices reported by "Inside F.E.R.C.'s Gas Market Report" for gas delivered to Sumas on the Northwest Pipeline, on a monthly basis, and as outlined in Appendix A of the Agreement; and
- D. The Commission reviewed the Application and finds that approval of amendments to Tariff Supplement No. 30 are necessary and in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders as follows:

1. The Commission approves for BC Gas amendments to Gas Tariff Supplement No. 30 Interruptible Gas Service Agreement with the Joint Venture covering off-system natural gas sales, effective for the month commencing May 1, 1992 as follows:.

> First Revision of Pages 30-1 to 30-7 inclusive Original Pages 30-8 and 30-9
