O R D E R

WHEREAS:

- A. On April 27, 1992, Centra Gas British Columbia Inc. ("Centra Gas") filed for Commission approval of a rate for transportation service for customers on Vancouver Island and the Sunshine Coast, served by the Pacific Coast Energy Corporation's pipeline system; and
- B. The new rate, identified as Transportation Service Rate No. 1 (TS-1), is available to customers with a minimum annual volume of 6,000 GJ; and
- C. The Commission has reviewed the Application as directed in Special Direction No. 5 and finds that approval of a transportation rate for Centra Gas is necessary and in the public interest.


NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders as follows:

- 1. The Commission approves and accepts for filing, for Centra Gas, Gas Tariff Rate Schedule, effective May 1, 1992 on an interim basis as follows:

Original Page C1.8 - Transportation Service Rate No. 1 (TS-1)
- 2. The Commission's approval is subject to a determination of Centra Gas' cost of service and rate base at a public hearing to be set by a future Commission Order.
