## ORDER

## WHEREAS:

- A. On November 24, 1993 Northland Utilities (B.C.) Limited ("NUL") applied to the Commission for approval to record in a deferral account the costs associated with its Integrated Resource Plan ("IRP") incurred to the date of its application and future IRP costs that will be incurred in 1994; and
- B. The Commission has reviewed the Application and finds that a deferral account to record IRP costs is appropriate and in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders NUL as follows:

- 1. The Commission approves for NUL, pursuant to Section 67(4) of the Utilities Commission Act, the use of a deferral account to record the costs associated with NUL's IRP for 1993 and 1994, with such balances attracting interest at the average prime rate of the utility's principle bank.
- 2. The disposition of the IRP deferral account will be determined by the Commission, or at the next public hearing into NUL's application for revenue requirements.
