WHEREAS:

- A. On December 3, 1993 Enershare Technology Corporation ("Enershare") applied to the Commission for approval to return its Agents/Brokers/Marketers Licence Certificate No. A-1-93 ("A/B/M Licence") issued by the Commission pursuant to Order No. A-1-93; and
