- A. On February 19, 1993 British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority ("B.C. Hydro") ("the Applicant") filed with the Commission for approval an Application, pursuant to Sections 64, 67, 106 and 114 of the Utilities Commission Act ("the Act") and Special Direction No. 8, to increase rates on an interim and permanent basis to all customers effective April 1, 1993; and

- E. The Commission has received Notices of Intervention as requested.
