WHEREAS:


- A. On July 8, 1993 BC Gas Inc. - Lower Mainland Division ("BC Gas") filed an application with the Commission for approval to replace the Agreement under Rate Schedule 2502 with Newstech Recycling Limited Partnership ("Newstech") with an Agreement dated May 25 and 28, 1993, that will allow the company to use gas from the Coquitlam, B.C. landfill; and
- B. In the Agreement dated May 25 and 28, 1993, BC Gas agreed to waive the exclusivity provisions set out in the standard sales agreement under Rate Schedule 2502, so long as landfill gas is the only fuel used to displace natural gas; and
- C. The Commission has reviewed the Application and finds that its approval is necessary and in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders as follows:

1. The Commission approves the Agreement between BC Gas and Newstech dated May 25 and 28, 1993 as BC Gas - Tariff Supplement No. 2 to Rate Schedule 2502 for Newstech, effective immediately as follows:
 - First Revision of Page No. 2.
 - Original Pages No. 2-1 to 2-3 inclusive.
