ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On August 10, 1993 BC Gas Utility Ltd. ("BC Gas Utility") applied, pursuant to Section 67(4) of the Utilities Commission Act ("the Act"), to recover a 0.5 percent increase in the Provincial Corporation Income Tax Rate that became effective on July 1, 1993 and a 0.8 cent per litre increase in the Motor Fuel Tax Rate that became effective on April 1, 1993; and
- B. BC Gas Utility applied for Commission approval to record the costs from July 1 to December 31, 1993 in a deferral account with such amounts collected to be amortized in 1994; and
- C. The Commission has reviewed the Application and finds that approval is necessary and in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission Orders as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to Section 67(4) of the Act, the Commission approves the Application of BC Gas Utility for the recording in a deferral account effective July 1 to December 31, 1993, the 0.5 percent increase in the Provincial Corporation Income Tax Rate and a 0.8 cent per litre increase in the Motor Fuel Tax Rate.
- 2. The amounts set aside in the deferral account accumulated to December 31, 1993 are to be recovered from customers and amortized over the 12 month period ending December 31, 1994.
