ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On December 22, 1994 Princeton Light and Power Company, Limited ("PLP") filed an application for an increase in rates of 2.49 percent as a result of increased power purchase costs from its supplier, West Kootenay Power Ltd. ("WKP"), effective January 1, 1995, made necessary by Commission Orders No. G-41-94 and G-100-94, approving for WKP a cumulative increase in rates of 4.7 percent effective January 1, 1995; and
- B. The Commission has considered the Application and is satisfied that an increase in rates for PLP is necessary and in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders as follows:

- 1. The Commission approves for PLP an increase in rates of 2.49 percent, effective January 1, 1995.
- 2. The Commission will accept, subject to timely filing, amended Electric Tariff rate schedules that embody the increase approved by this Order.
- 3. PLP will provide all customers with an appropriate notice of explanation of the rate increase and its effect on monthly electricity bills by way of a bill stuffer and will publish a notice in the Community newspaper.
