ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On January 22, 1996 British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority ("B.C. Hydro") filed its Industrial Service Options ("ISO") application and requested approval of Rate Schedule 1848 Real Time Pricing ("RTP") Transmission Service (5,000 kVA and over) on an interim basis, effective January 31, 1996; and
- B. The Commission reviewed the ISO application and, by Order No. G-5-96, approved Rate Schedule 1848 RTP on an interim basis effective January 31, 1996; and
- C. On January 25, 1996 B.C. Hydro applied to the Commission for approval of a January 10, 1996 application by Sterling Pulp Chemicals Ltd. ("Sterling") for access to the RTP option with a 50 percent reduction in Customer Baseline Load, under the Load Retention criteria of the ISO application; and
- D. The Commission has reviewed the B.C. Hydro and Sterling applications and finds that they satisfy the criteria contained in Rate Schedule 1848.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders B.C. Hydro as follows:

- 1. The Commission approves, on an interim basis, effective January 31, 1996, the B.C. Hydro January 25, 1996 application on behalf of Sterling for access to the RTP option with a 50 percent reduction in the Customer Baseline Load as provided for under Rate Schedule 1848. This will result in a Customer Baseline Load for Sterling in the order of 25 MW.
- 2. The Commission will approve, subject to timely filing by B.C. Hydro, a Supplementary Agreement to Sterling's Electricity Supply Agreement that embodies a 50 percent reduction in Customer Baseline Load.
- 3. The approval of Rate Schedule 1848, and the RTP option, given by this Order will remain in effect on an interim basis for a period of up to one year from January 31, 1996 and is subject to adjustment following the Commission's hearing and Decision on B.C. Hydro's ISO application.
