ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On January 27, 1995 Newcal Energy Inc. ("Newcal") filed an application to amend rates contained in Crude Petroleum Tariff for the Inga Oil Transmission Pipeline for transportation of product effective April 1, 1995, pursuant to Part 7 of the Pipeline Act; and
- B. The rates contained in the Tariff apply to the gathering and transportation of crude petroleum at the pipeline segments designated as Inga South and East; and
- C. In February 1995 two shippers on the pipeline, Pembina Resources Limited and Harvard International Resources Ltd., objected to the tariff revisions and certain costs contained in the Application; and
- D. Newcal responded to the shippers' objections and filed a revised Application on March 22, 1995; and
- E. The Commission has considered Newcal's revised Application and finds that it is in accordance with the requirements of the Act.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders as follows:

Pursuant to Part 7 of the Pipeline Act, the rates contained in Newcal's Crude Petroleum Tariff submitted on March 22, 1995 are approved and accepted for filing, effective April 1, 1995.
