The Commission Panel requests that a summary or synopsis, including documentation if any, concerning the role of the consultant and the assistance provided by this consultant to the organization and process, be filed in support of the funding request. The information requested is not to breach the confidentiality of the NSP process, but is solely to meet the needs of the Commission in making its cost award determination.
