## ORDER

## WHEREAS:

- A. On March 7, 1996 Federated Pipe Lines (Western) Ltd. ("Federated") filed with the Commission an application for approval of an increase in tolls of approximately 6.25 percent on its Taylor to Prince George and Taylor to Kamloops Crude Oil Pipeline ("the Pipeline") effective January 1, 1996 in accordance with the incentive tolling methodology; and
- B. On March 7, 1996 Federated confirmed that it reviewed the proposed toll revision with the Shippers on the Pipeline and determined that none of the Shippers intended to file a complaint; and
- C. The Commission has considered the Application and finds that approval is required.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to Part 7 of the Pipeline Act the Commission approves Federated's March 7, 1996 application for a revision of Tariff No. 24 allowing for a permanent increase of approximately 6.25 percent effective January 1, 1996, subject to review in the event of a complaint.
- 2. Federated is to deliver a copy of this Order and approved Tariff No. 24 to all Shippers on the Pipeline.
