## ORDER

## **WHEREAS:**

- A. The Commission, by Order No. G-85-97, approved for BC Gas Utility Ltd. ("BC Gas") its 1998-2000 Revenue Requirements by way of a Negotiated Settlement Agreement. Following the Negotiated Settlement a series of separate negotiating meetings were held to review BC Gas' gas cost incentive plan which was to expire on November 1, 1997; and
- B. The parties negotiated a settlement with respect to BC Gas' gas cost incentive plan for the 1997/98 gas contract year. Commission Order No. G-125-97 approved for BC Gas the 1997/98 Gas Supply Mitigation Incentive Program ("GSMIP"); and
- C. On December 1, 1997, the British Columbia Public Interest Advocacy Centre ("BCPIAC") applied for a participant assistance cost award for its participation in the BC Gas GSMIP proceeding; and
- D. The Commission has determined that participation by BCPIAC in the GSMIP proceeding requires reimbursement in accordance with Commission approved guidelines; and
- E. The Commission has discussed the claim having regard to the criteria and rates set out in Order No. G-103-96.

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## **NOW THEREFORE** the Commission orders as follows:

1. Pursuant to Section 118(1) of the Utilities Commission Act, the Commission awards funds to BCPIAC in the amount of \$2,329.63 for its participation in the BC Gas - Gas Supply Mitigation Incentive proceeding.

2. BC Gas is directed to reimburse BCPIAC for the total amount awarded in a timely fashion.
