ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On July 24, 2000, Princeton Light and Power Company, Limited ("PLP") applied for Commission approval to amend and renew its operating credit facilities and long-term debt credit agreement, pursuant to Section 49 of the Utilities Commission Act ("the Act"); and
- B. The July 4, 2000 Credit Agreement with the Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce ("CIBC") provides for a transfer from the short-term operating loan facilities of \$477,902 to the long-term portfolio and to refinance its Credit B facility from 7.70 percent to 7.85 percent for a five-year term and a ten-year amortization effective July 1, 2000; and
- C. The Commission has considered the application and supporting material and finds that approval of the loan restructuring agreement with CIBC is appropriate.
