ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. The Commission, by Order No. P-3-98, approved the methodology for calculating the revenue requirement for Trans Mountain Enterprises of British Columbia Limited ("TME") for the years 1998 to 2002 inclusive, subject to review in the event of a complaint; and
- B. On February 28, 2001, TME filed with the Commission an application to set permanent tolls, effective January 1, 2001, in accordance with the 1998 to 2002 Incentive Agreement and Commission Order No. P-3-98; and
- C. TME confirmed that a draft copy of the application was circulated to its Shippers on February 7, 2001, and that no objections had been received. A copy of the final application was provided to Shippers on February 28, 2001, and in a March 12, 2001 letter, Bull, Housser & Tupper, Solicitors representing the Vancouver Fuel Committee at the Vancouver International Airport, stated that they had no objection to the application, but expressed concern regarding cost increases on two projects undertaken by TME; and
- D. The Commission has reviewed the application and finds that approval of the 2001 tolls for the Jet Fuel Pipeline is required.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders as follows:

- 1. The Commission approves for TME the 2001 tolls on the Jet Fuel Pipeline, pursuant to Section 44 of the Pipeline Act, that allows for an increase of approximately 6.05 percent, effective January 1, 2001, subject to review in the event of a complaint.
- 2. TME is to provide all Shippers on the Jet Fuel Pipeline with a copy of this Order and approved permanent tolls effective January 1, 2001.
