O R D E R

WHEREAS:

- A. The Commission, by Order No. G-59-00, approved for Aquila Networks Canada (British Columbia) Ltd. ("Aquila") (formerly known as West Kootenay Power Ltd.) and British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority ("B.C. Hydro") a Letter Agreement between Aquila and B.C. Hydro for Wholesale Transmission Service ("WTS") from Aquila's South Slokan Generating Station to its Princeton, B.C. substation during off-peak hours during the period from May 20 to July 31, 2000; and
- B. The Agreement provided for a renewal of the wheeling agreement terms between April 1 to July 31, 2001; and
- C. On June 19, 2002, Aquila applied to the Commission for approval of a June 17, 2002 Letter Agreement with B.C. Hydro to extend the WTS Agreement from South Slokan to Princeton for the period June 19, 2002 to July 31, 2002; and
- D. The Commission has reviewed the 2002 Letter Agreement and finds that it should be approved.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission approves for Aquila and B.C. Hydro the June 17, 2002 Letter Agreement extending the May 16, 2000 WTS Agreement for the transmission of power from Aquila's South Slokan Generating Station to Aquila's Princeton, B.C. Substation during off-peak hours for the period June 19, 2002 to July 31, 2002.
